The Parents as Teacher's program is FREE and available to anyone living within Lancaster County. We partner with parents beginning in the prenatal stage through the first five years of their child's life. Families can be referred any time before their child's third birthday. Each family will be paired with a parent educator who will come to their home one to two times a month, bringing customized activities, parent handouts, and children's books that the family can keep. **Parents as Teachers** is a great way to maximize your parenting skills and prepare your child for kindergarten!
